



## CARVOEIRO GARDENS LANDSCAPING

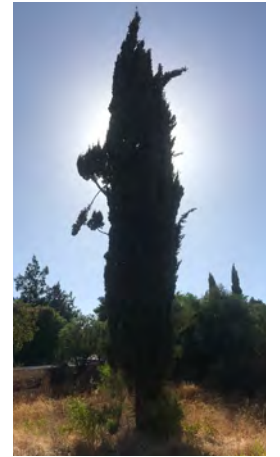


Offering views over the ocean to the south and the Monchique mountain-range to the north, Carvoeiro Gardens is situated in the very heart of the Algarve.

Expansive lawns and palm trees can be found all over the world, but this was not our vision. Rather, we wanted to show off the natural beauty of this stunning corner of the world.





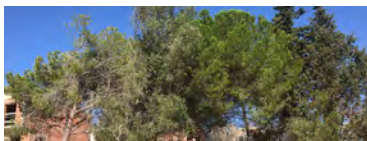
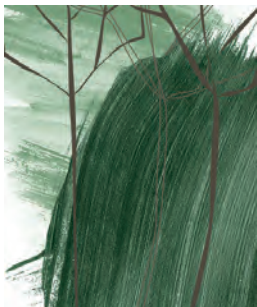
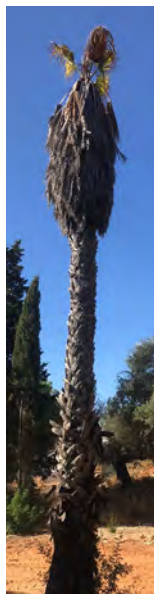
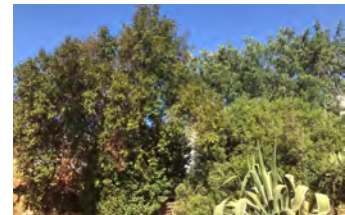
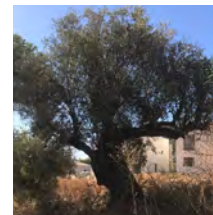
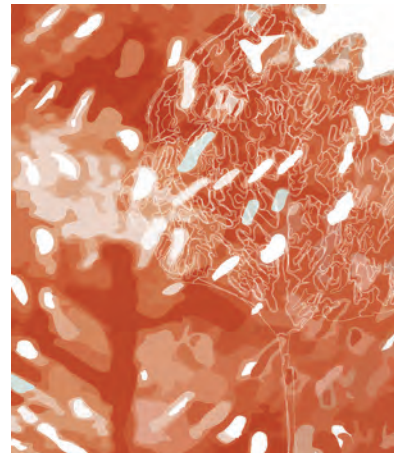
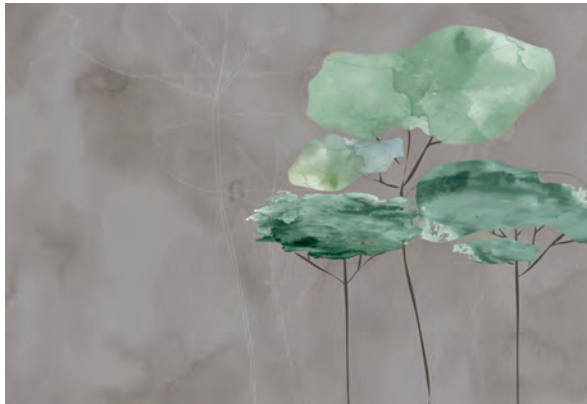
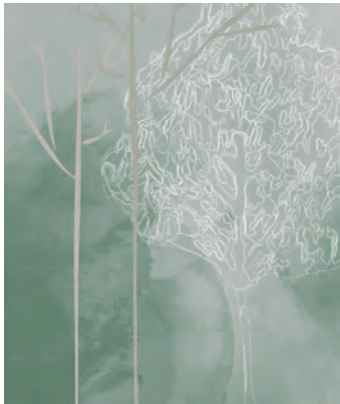
## EXISTING PLANTATIONS INDIGENOUS FLORA & FAUNA
